



Hot dots are a wonderful quizzing, accessing and repetitive learning tool. I have used these for years with my children and they enjoy them.

I have made up an example file folder here showing how you can make “generic” answer pockets for any materials you wish to insert into the pockets for learning or quizzing.

The Hot Dot pen can be tapped onto an answer circle. The circles are already programs to sound off as a correct answer or an incorrect answer.

I have labeled these pockets with answer slots A, B,C,D or Yes, No or just blank and I write in answer choices with an overhead (water based) marker. That way no matter what I insert into the pocket, there is a way of assess that material.

For instance, on this pocket, the child looks at the word choices and selects whether or not these are short e words. He will select yes or no.

For option, I inserted a president’s picture card and they select the correct answer from one I have written in.

This activity has an infinite number of applications and is useable for any age.
